The foundations work for the new school building is complete. The concrete superstructure frame is progressing well and is scheduled to complete on time. The concrete superstructure includes concrete columns, walls and suspended slabs.

Construction traffic volume has reduced over the last month. We have trained traffic marshals to help safely manage the movement of vehicles when they enter or leave the site. In addition, vehicle entry points are controlled by gatemen for public safety.

The footpath along Donegal Street has been adapted to accommodate the construction work adjacent to the site boundary. The appropriate street-works barriers, ramps and signage is installed and the work is closely managed. Please take care if you are in this area.

The lifting operations adjacent to the site boundary are closely monitored by managers and supervisors to ensure there is no risk of any injury or damage to property.

The site is completely secured with timber hoarding, gates and lighting for public protection. The site is also manned by 24 hour security.
